




# ROYAL ASCOT

WINDSOR ENCLOSURE

Royal Ascot is renowned across the globe. Underpinned with a rich and deep-rooted heritage, the Royal Meeting has not only survived the rigours of time, it has thrived. It is an experience shaped by the iconic moments that punctuate each day, declared underway by the Royal Procession as the clock strikes two. Though there are nuanced variations that differentiate one day from the next, each shares the same glorious atmosphere and sense of occasion, each is unmistakably Royal Ascot.

The clock strikes two and so begins the Royal Procession. The Royal Landaus, led by four Windsor Greys, approach along the famous Straight Mile. It's a short but spectacular journey, and one that since 1825 has signalled the start of the Royal Meeting.

**Racing**

With prize money of more than £7 million, Royal Ascot will host a stellar field of the world's finest racehorses. Each day features six world-class Flat races with prize money of over £1 million per day.

## DRESS CODE

Please note, there is a charge of £10 for children aged 10-17 to attend Royal Ascot in the Windsor Enclosure. These tickets can be purchased from the Windsor Enclosure Ticket Office on the day of attendance and cannot be purchased in advance. An adult must accompany each child/children and show their own ticket as proof of attendance. Identification may be requested to identify each child's age. All proceeds from child tickets go to Ascot's Annual Charitable Giving.





## FOOD AND DRINK

*The atmosphere in the Windsor Enclosure is always vibrant with guests enjoying artisan foods, Champagne, cocktails and picnics on the lawn.*

A range of on-the-go dining is available in the Windsor Enclosure, including deli-style snacks and filling hot meals at the Silver Street Food Market, plus a selection of bars. New to the Windsor Enclosure this year is Temper, an open kitchen grill and taco bar, by Neil Rankin, chef and owner of three Temper restaurants in London. Temper offers tacos, sharing steaks, saddleback pork, grilled chicken and lamb chops with main courses starting at £12.

## RACECOURSE ADDRESS

Ascot Racecourse, Ascot, Berkshire, SL5 7JX.

## BY ROAD


Please note that roads around the racecourse will be congested and journey times may be considerably longer due to the high number of visitors. Parking labels can easily be purchased in advance by calling **0344 346 3000** or visiting **ascot.co.uk**. For the quickest route to your car park, please follow the designated colour-coded travel signs which match your car park label (rather than following your satellite navigation). If you plan to arrive by taxi, a drop-off point is located in Car Park 3.

## BY RAIL

For those arriving by train (27 minutes from Reading, 52 minutes from London Waterloo), the racecourse is just a 10-minute uphill walk from Ascot station. **For train times visit [nationalrail.co.uk](http://nationalrail.co.uk).**

## SECURITY

Please be aware that due to increased security measures at our racecourse entrances there may be delays, so please leave plenty of time to get into the venue.
