Royal Procession

The clock strikes two and so begins the Royal Procession. The Royal Landaus, led by four Windsor Greys, approach along the famous Straight Mile. It's a short but spectacular journey, and one that since 1825 has signalled the start of the Royal Meeting.

2.30 - 5.35pm

Racing

Positioned on the rails for the final furlong, The Village provides a breathtaking view of the finest horses in the world as they thunder down the home straight.

11.00am - 9.00pm

Entertainment

Live music throughout the day from upbeat DJ sets in the Sperry Tent to acoustic sessions and jazz bands on The Bandstand stage. The Main stage in The Village has live performances from the best party bands (Thursday - Saturday 6pm-9pm).

CHILD TICKETS

Please note, there is a charge of £15 for children aged 10-17 to attend the Village Enclosure. These tickets can be purchased from the Village Enclosure Ticket Office on the day of attendance and cannot be purchased in advance. An adult must accompany the child/children and show their own ticket as proof of attendance. Identification may be requested to identify each child's age. All proceeds from child tickets go to Ascot's Annual Charitable Giving.

DRESS CODE

LADIES

Ladies within the Village Enclosure are required to dress in a manner as befits a formal occasion and are kindly asked to take note of the following:

- A hat, headpiece or fascinator should be worn at all times.
- Strapless and sheer dresses and tops are not permitted. Please note our definition of strapless necklines include off-the-shoulder, Bardot and one shoulder.
- Trouser suits must be full-length and jumpsuits should fall below the knee. Both must adhere to the neckline regulations above.
- Midriffs must be covered.
- Shorts are not permitted.

Please note, the Village Enclosure is a grassed area and ladies should consider their hat size and shoes accordingly. Smaller hats or fascinators and wedges or block heels are recommended in place of large headwear or stilettos.

GENTLEMEN

Gentlemen are required to wear a jacket, full-length trousers, collared shirt and tie, and are kindly asked to take note of the following:

- A tie should be worn at all times. Bow ties or cravats can also be worn in the Village Enclosure.
- Socks must be worn and should cover the ankle.
- Jeans, trainers and shorts are not permitted.

GIRLS

Girls aged 17 and under should be dressed for a formal occasion. Smart summer dresses are suggested. Hats, headpieces and fascinators may be worn but are not compulsory.

BOYS

Boys aged 10-17 should wear a suit or jacket with a shirt and tie. Younger boys nine and under should be dressed smartly but are not required to wear a jacket or tie.

BY ROAD

Please note that roads around the racecourse will be congested and journey times may be considerably longer due to the high number of visitors. Parking labels can easily be purchased in advance by calling **0344 346 3000** or visiting ascot.co.uk. For the quickest route to your car park, please follow the designated colour-coded travel signs which match your car park label (rather than following your satellite navigation). If you plan to arrive by taxi, a drop-off point is located in Car Park 3.

BY RAIL

For those arriving by train (27 minutes from Reading, 52 minutes from London Waterloo), the racecourse is just a 10-minute uphill walk from Ascot station.

Please be aware that due to increased security measures at our racecourse entrances there may be delays, so please leave plenty of time to get into the venue.




THE ASCOT SHOP


